Health and Safety Guidelines – Lotus Villa

To ensure a safe and secure environment at Lotus Villa we request your co-operation in following the below guidelines issue by the health authorities.

- The Sri Lankan greeting “Ayubowan” will be always used instead of handshakes, hugging or kissing.
- No stopping allowed during the airport transfers. Wash room facilities, Money changing and SIM card purchasing should be arranged at the Airport before start the pickup transfer to Lotus Villa.
- Face masks should be worn when staying in public areas.
- On arrival PCR test will be scheduled when the guest arrives in Lotus Villa. Until the test report is issued, guests need to follow room quarantine and Meals with other essential room services will be provided. (Not applicable for fully vaccinated travelers)
- Make sure the safe distance of 1.5 meters is always maintained with each other.
- Washing of hands is compulsory when entering to the Restaurant, consultation room, treatment center, yoga hall, relaxing area, public washrooms, and other public areas.
- Face mask should be worn during each treatment.
- Reduce cash handling and request to pay extra bills using online payment transfers.
- Disposable face masks, gloves, face shields and other personal protective equipment should be disposed into the blue bins placed in designated areas.
- Use of public transport is not allowed.
- Swimming pool and beach are allowed to use. Beach access time limited from 02.00 p.m. to 06.00 p.m.
- Moving with the local communities residing around the Hotel, restricted for safety reasons as per the Medical Officer of Health directions.
- Regular excursions are not allowed at present and if the regulations released, only approved tourist sites can be visited.
- The conditions related to health imposed by the government authorities in Sri Lanka and the MOH officials from time to time should be adhered to.
