Health and Safety Guidelines – Lotus Villa

To ensure a safe and secure environment at Lotus Villa we request your co-operation in following the below guidelines issued by the health authorities.

- The Sri Lankan greeting “Ayubowan” will be always used instead of handshakes, hugging or kissing.
- We avoid stopping during airport transfers for hygiene reasons. Therefore, it is recommended to use washroom facilities and SIM card purchasing at the Airport before starting the pickup transfer to Lotus Villa.
- We highly request and recommend complying with hygiene practices such as hand washing, hand sanitizing when entering to the Restaurant, consultation room, treatment center, yoga hall, public washrooms, and other public areas.
- Disposed face masks, gloves, face shields and other personal protective equipment should be disposed into the blue bins placed in designated areas.
- For hygienic purposes Use of public transport is not recommended. Lotus Villa can arrange transport services on request.
- Excursions will be arranged usually as per the health guidelines.
- Swimming pool and beach are allowed to use. Beach access time limited until 07.00 p.m. from morning time. Depending on the condition of the Sea and recommendation of Chief Doctor it is ok to have a Sea bath.
- Moving with the local communities residing around the Hotel, restricted for safety reasons as per the Medical Officer of Health directions.
- The conditions related to health imposed by the government authorities in Sri Lanka and the MOH officials from time to time should be adhered to.
